



## Family-Type Homes (FTH)

Family-type Homes for Adults (FTH)\* are private homes which provide an atmosphere of family living for adults who are unable to live on their own. FTH are provided by people (homeowners or renters) who have a desire to help others and have extra room in their homes. Residents are people 18 years of age and older who cannot live alone and may be unable to maintain their own home because of advanced age or physical or developmental disabilities, yet they do not need the skilled medical and nursing services provided in nursing homes. Some residents may need supervision and assistance with personal care. Each home is limited to a maximum of four residents unrelated to the provider. These homes are certified by the New York State Office of Children and Family Services. They are inspected on a 12-18 month basis by the Monroe County Office of Children and Family Services. \*Definition excerpts from the NYS Office of Family and Children Services
