



Nursing Homes Compare (Star Ratings for Monroe County as of September 2022)

Nursing homes vary in the quality of care and services they provide for residents. Reviewing health inspection results, staffing data, and quality measure data are three important ways to measure nursing home quality. This information gives you a "snap shot" of the care individual nursing homes provide. The following information is compiled from Medicare.gov (Nursing Home Compare), the official US government site for Medicare https://www.medicare.gov/care-compare/

Overall rating:

The overall star rating for nursing homes lets you compare nursing homes on topics you consider most important, and gives you a "snapshot" of the quality of each nursing home. The rating, between 1 to 5 stars, combines results and data from 3 important sources, including: Health Inspections, Staffing & Quality Measures as listed below. https://www.medicare.gov/care-compare/resources/nursing-home/overall-star-rating

Health inspections rating: Based on the three most recent comprehensive (annual) inspections, and inspections due to complaints in the last three years. This information is gathered by trained, objective inspectors who go onsite to the nursing home and follow a specific process to determine the extent to which a nursing home has met Medicaid and Medicare's minimum quality requirements. Staffing rating: The staffing rating has information about the number of hours of care provided on average to each resident each day by nursing staff. This rating considers differences in the levels of residents' care need in each nursing home. For more detailed information go to:

Quality measures (QM) rating: The quality measure rating has information on 15 different physical and clinical measures for nursing home residents. The QMs offer information about how well nursing homes are caring for their residents' physical and clinical needs. The five-star quality rating system isn't a substitute for visiting the nursing home. This system can give you important information, help you compare nursing homes by topics you consider most important, and help you think of questions to ask when you visit the nursing home.
