Department of Motor Vehicles Abstract of Driving Record	Obtain a copy of someone's driving record/abstract for the past four years.	This request can be made in person at the DMV or by mail. It may be requested by the motorist or it may be requested with a notarized statement by the motorist giving permission to the record requester to obtain their driving record from the DMV. Government Agencies (excluding hospitals, nonprofits or private entities) Freedom of Information Law (FOIL)	The Freedom of Information Law (FOIL) provides public access to records held by federal or public authorities, this can include criminal reports or complaints to law enforcement agencies. Requests should be in writing and come to the agency through mail, fax, email or an online form on the agency's website. You may wish to obtain records from the Sheriff's Office and local Police Department(s)-this would require two or more individual FOIL requests. An initial acknowledgement or response to a request is typically made within five business days. Tips for making a FOIL request: Try to be as specific as possible when requesting information. Provide name, date of birth, and any other identifying information you have for the individual you are requesting information on. Request any criminal reports and complaints for the specific individual. (You may end up being requested to further identify records sought) Some agencies will charge copying costs per page — usually about \$0.25 per page. Asking the agency to email the records instead could cut costs, but there is typically no charge to inspect the documents in person.
