Transportation Resources

Monroe County has many transportation options available for older adults and individuals with disabilities for medical appointments, errands and social events. These options include services offered by volunteers, public services, private vendors and medical transportation providers. Through Lifespan's TRAC (Transportation Access) Program, mobility specialists can help Monroe County residents or their caregivers explore options available to them. (TRAC is not a transportation provider, rather a service to explore transportation options.) Transportation needs to start in the county the person resides in. If exploring transportation options for someone who resides in another county in New York state, please contact NY Connects at 1-800-342-9871 to be transferred to the appropriate county.

Donation Based/Volunteer Programs

This section focuses in on transportation options for specific areas of Monroe County and those who may be connected with a specific support need. While many of these options have age requirements, a few also expand this to individuals with disabilities. Most programs have volunteer drivers. Riders need to be able to transfer themselves in and out of vehicles and be able to walk on their own (or with a cane or walker.) Many programs do not charge fees, but graciously accept donations. For those requesting fees, it is intended to be affordable. Many of these programs work in conjunction with Lifespan's Give-a-Lift program to provide training to volunteer drivers on safety, sensitivity to physical impairments (visual and hearing), and signs of elder abuse. Drivers also are screened through license, reference, and background checks. They are also required to have COVID vaccines. These services are indicated below with (GAL).

Medical/Private Company Transportation Providers

Many of the providers will provide non-urgent rides to medical appointments for a fee. Some provide transportation to social events and errands. Drivers are employees of the provider and are subject to the provider's hiring and training practices. Many providers provide door to door services, meaning if rider needs additional assistance, driver can bring into appointment/event location rather than being dropped off at curb. Rates vary per provider and mobility needs of rider. Cost increases when more support is needed. For "ambulatory" transportation, some charge a flat fee, some charge flat fee plus mileage for longer fares, others charge per mile. Wheelchair transportation can range from \$35 to \$135 each way plus mileage. Stretcher transportation rates can be around \$120 plus mileage each way. As rates fluctuate, it is encouraged to call the provider for exact fare. These services are available for all age groups.

Transportation Type Key:

(A) Ambulatory: Rider needs to be able to walk and transfer on their own, may need a cane or walker. Can be transported in a car or van.

(TC) Folding (Transport) Chair: Rider can transfer into vehicle on own or minimal guidance, wheelchair can fold up. May be able to be transported in a car. (W)Wheelchair Transportation: Rider needs to be transported in their wheelchair due to inability to transfer independently, and typically would need to be brought into medical appointments. Must have a ramp or family assistance to exit the home. Usually transported in a van with a lift. This sort of support is also for scooters and power chairs.

(S) Stretcher Transportation: For individuals who are unable to get out of their home unassisted, would need stretcher. Also known by some providers as ambulette services.

Driver Evaluation Programs

Driver evaluation programs can assess the driving skills of a person who may have conditions which may affect their driving. Typically done in a 3-step process, a person has their physical and mental abilities evaluated for safe driving, a behind the wheel driving evaluation and, if recommended, a driver training program. <u>https://dmv.ny.gov/older-driver/driver-rehabilitation-program-faqs</u>

Unfortunately, there may be a time where a person's ability to drive may come into question due to medical or cognitive issues. A physician, police officer or concerned citizen can submit a written report of concerns to the New York State Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV). The DMV can suspend a driver's license from physician report until a physician certifies the medical/cognitive issue is treated or controlled.
